The Bible tell us about the Servant of God who was born and have pain when God sees her pain, All became well;

Why God sees your Pain?

The only thing you need to find out about what God is doing for your pain.

The Bible tells us the story of Haggai, an Egyptian and Sarai, Abram's Wife who had no children. Sarai told Abram to go and sleep with their maidservant Haggai, so that perhaps they could build a family through her. Abram agreed to what Sarai said and the maidservant Haggai was taken to Abram. After he slept with Haggai and she knew that she was pregnant, she began to despise her mistress

There are three ways of trouble you may encounter that enables God to see your pain.

1.

Haggai was brought from Egypt and because she had no choice she left that happen. When you have pain God sees what you are going through.

If a person has more authority than you and has an intention to punish you, God sees your pain. When you have no control, just cry to the Lord and God will see your pain.

2. Those who mistreat you:

Sarai entreated Abram to sleep with their maidservant Haggai so that she can build a family through her

The Angle appeared to Haggai and pronounced something because of the tears of Sarai. When you cry to the Lord, God sees your pain

3. Children can cause you trouble:

When Haggai gave birth, she was happy but at times she was saddened when Sarai realized that she had began to despise her. Sarai mistreated Haggai and she fled from her

God can see your pain between you and your children. Remember, you might be a great sinner today and when God sees you all will be ok

God sees your pain and has prepared a future for you.

In conclusion, It doesn't matter what you are passing through today. It might be the pain of losing a Job, pain of sickness or pain of life. Remember, God sees your pain and All will be well.
